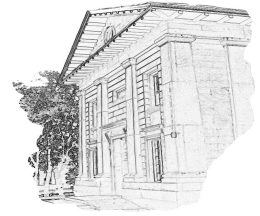

Second Collection for the Apostleship of the Sea this weekend 10th / 11th July at all Masses.

Today is **Sea Sunday**, when the Church remembers all those who live and work at sea. Many people have never stopped to consider how important seafarers are to our standard of living. Without them we would not have most of the items we use in our everyday lives. Many of these seafarers do not have the quality of life on board that every human has the right to.

The Apostleship of the Sea (AOS) is the official maritime welfare agency of the Catholic Church in Great Britain. The Apostleship of the Sea reaches out to seafarers that visit our ports each year, offering pastoral and practical support and care. AOS is wholly dependent on voluntary donations to continue its work; it takes the love of Christ to seafarers in the name of the Church, recognising them as our brothers and sisters in need.

Sea Sunday is the principal fundraising and awareness-raising event of the year for AOS. Today's second collection will be taken at Masses throughout the country, this annual event is absolutely vital for AOS to continue their work. Please give generously, and remember seafarers in your prayers.

First Holy Communion: A big thank you to all who helped in any way with the organisation and preparation of the children of St Mary's who received the Sacrament last weekend. The service was enjoyable and uplifting, the highlight of our parish year. Please keep all the children in your daily prayers and we pray that as they receive the Eucharist of the Lord each week they may grow in the deeper knowledge of His love for them.

The Sacraments: A new series of sacramental programmes will commence in September. As the resident priest in Glossop, Father Uche will work with the two sets of catechists to provide programmes throughout the year, and celebrate Baptism, Reconciliation, Holy Communion and Confirmation with his people. The next **Baptism** course is in September. To join the course, please fill in the application forms at the back of church and return to the parish office at Royle House, All Saints by **July 31st 2010**. Once you have done this, you are automatically accepted on to the course so please just turn up on the evenings. In the meantime it is hoped that you will continue to attend Mass each weekend and keep up to date with any further information through our parish newsletter.

Parish Finances:

Father John wishes to inform the people of All Saints parish that he received a letter from the financial office of the diocese to say that over the last few years they have struggled to balance the books, and these are showing a deficit; they have had to resort to using the offset account to support the parish. Father John will contact the parish accountant to try to clarify some of the issues and will come back to you as soon as he can, because he believes this has to be addressed by all of the parish. Father John feels that the present difficulties may be due to the refurbishment of Royle House over recent years.

Visits to the Sick and Housebound: Father John is pleased that Father Uche has visited some of the sick and housebound of the parish, but can the Eucharistic Ministers who have yet to contact him please do so and arrange dates in the near future.

The annual **Padley Pilgrimage** takes place on **Sunday July 11th**. Many people already take part and Father John would like to encourage as many as possible from the parish to come along. This is an inter-diocesan pilgrimage in honour of the Padley martyrs Blessed Robert Ludlam and Blessed Nicholas Garlick. The guest speaker is the Most Reverend Vincent Nicholls, Archbishop of Westminster. You are asked to assemble at 3pm at Grindleford Station. **Mass commences at 3.30pm.** The reign of Elizabeth I was a time of religious persecution for English Catholics. In the early morning of July 12th 1588, Padley Manor, the residence of the Fitzherbert family, was raided. Two travelling priests and everyone at the hall were arrested. Garlick and Ludlam, and another priest, Richard Simpson, were gruesomely executed in Derby within the fortnight.
