Assisted Suicide / Euthanasia ("mercy killing") proposals in Parliament. **SPUC** have written to tell us that a debate is expected to be held in the House of Lords on **Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> June**. They ask that as many people as possible write to members of the House of Lords to ask them to oppose this Bill which would lead to the weakening of the legal protection of vulnerable people - disabled, elderly or chronically sick.
