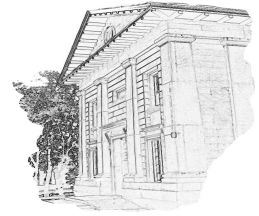

We welcome Father Uche back into our parish community this week and assure him of our continued prayer for him and his family.

Father John will be celebrating First Holy Communion at New Mills next Saturday, June 19th. Everyone is welcome to attend.

Father John is now up to date in preparation for and administering Baptism, Reconciliation and first Holy Communion. If he has missed anybody, please contact him as soon as possible to ensure that all preparation is complete for all families. A programme for the preparation for the sacraments is now in place.

Father John Writes : The issues of table fellowship appear here. Simon has ring-fenced his men-only dinner party within a zone of ritual purity only to have it gate crashed by a woman of ill repute! Both Simon and the woman are sinners. The host is appalled at Jesus' acceptance of the woman, whom he has judged to be sinful and unworthy of inclusion at their table. In a radical reversal of cultural norms Jesus welcomes her to the table. The authentic sorrow of the woman is contrasted with the self-righteousness of the Pharisee. The woman experiences forgiveness but the Pharisee does not. Forgiveness transforms the woman in a way that enables extravagant expressions of love. The Pharisee remains hardened of heart and unable to perform generous acts of love. Forgiveness transforms and generates love.
