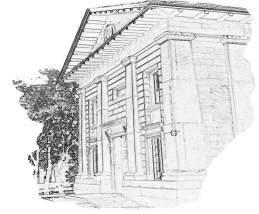

**Ash Wednesday - start of Lent:** The season of Lent is a preparation for the season of Easter. The Liturgy prepares the catechumens (those being received into the church this year) for the celebration of the Paschal mystery by the several stages of Christian initiation. It also prepares the faithful who recall their baptism and do penance in preparation for Easter. At the 10:00am Mass in All Saints the ashes will be blessed and imposed after the Gospel. **Ash Wednesday is a day of Fasting and Abstinence.**
