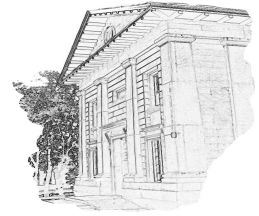

**Fr Benjamin Choyce** Father Choyce, who was Parish Priest at All Saints' from 1978 to 1989, died on the 19th June aged 95 years. Father Choyce was much loved and respected by all. He was a very holy man who cared deeply for his parishioners. May he rest in the eternal love and peace of God.

**Mass Intentions:** Father John wonders if we could have a really big push to get more Mass intentions for All Saints. There is no better way to give thanks or pray for those in need than through dedicating Holy Mass for that special intention. Not only does the Priest pray for your intention, but also all those attending Mass; and it really enhances the celebration.

**First Holy Communion:** A big thank you to all who helped in any way with the organisation and preparation of the children of All Saints who received the Sacrament last weekend. The whole service was enjoyable and uplifting, the highlight of our parish year. Please keep all the children in your daily prayers and we pray that as they receive the Eucharist of the Lord each week they may grow in the deeper knowledge of His love for them.

**The Sacraments:** A new series of sacramental programmes will commence in September. As the resident priest in Glossop, Father Uche will work with the two sets of catechists to provide programmes throughout the year, and celebrate Baptism, Reconciliation, Holy Communion and Confirmation with his people. To join the next **Baptism** course, in September, please fill in the application forms in church and return to the parish office at Royle House, All Saints by **July 31<sup>st</sup> 2010**. Having done this, you are automatically accepted on the course so just turn up on the evenings. In the meantime it is hoped that you will continue to attend Mass each weekend and keep up to date with further information through the newsletter.

**Cardinal John Henry Newman (1801-1890)** John Henry Newman was born in the City of London on 21st February 1801, the son of John Newman and Hemima Newman (nee Fourdrinier). He was the eldest of six children, three boys and three girls. As vicar of St. Mary's Oxford he exerted a profound spiritual influence on the Church of England. After joining the Catholic Church in 1845, he brought the oratory of St. Philip Neri to England, was the first Rector of the Catholic University in Dublin and was made Cardinal by Pope Leo XIII in 1879. He died in Birmingham on 11th August 1890.

**Prayers of Cardinal John Henry Newman** May He support us all the day long, till the shades lengthen and the evening comes, and the busy world is hushed, and the fever of life is over, and our work is done. Then in His mercy may He give us a safe lodging, and a holy rest and peace at the last. Oh my Lord and Saviour, support me in that hour in the strong arms of your Sacraments, and by the fresh fragrance of your consolations. Let the absolving words be said over me and the holy oil sign and seal me, and your own Body be my food, and your Blood my sprinkling; and let my sweet Mother, Mary, breathe on me, and my Angel whisper peace to me, and my glorious Saints smile upon me; that in them all and through them all, I may receive the gift of perseverance, and die, as I desire to live, in Your faith, in Your Church, in Your service, and in Your love, *Amen*.
