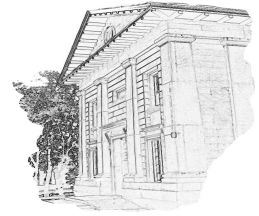

Father John Writes: Luke 9: 18-24

Marking another important moment in Jesus' Ministry and self-revelation, this passage opens with Jesus in prayer and reflective mode. Having engaged the disciples in a conversation about who they and others believe him to be, he reveals that he is not the type of Messiah expected by some, not a military leader come to liberate the Jews from their oppressors. He then presents to them the awesome prospect of his outright rejection and shameful death. Moreover, true discipleship is a radical path of true emptying. There is real sacrifice and suffering involved on this path, but the reward is transformation and freedom in Christ.

Father John is now up to date in preparation for and administering Baptism, Reconciliation and first Holy Communion. If he has missed anybody, please contact him as soon as possible to ensure that all preparation is complete for all families. A programme for the preparation for the sacraments is now in place.
