Abortion agency advertising on TV/radio. We have received a letter from Prof Jack Scarisbrick, Chairman of LIFE, thanking our parishioners for supporting LIFE's Petition to the Advertising Standards Agency against the proposal to allow abortion agencies to advertise on TV and radio. (A copy is on the church notice board.) Over 25,000 signatures were collected by LIFE and presented to the ASA. The ASA's Director of Communications confirmed to LIFE that there will now be extensive discussions between the ASA and other bodies, e.g. Ofcom, and that a decision will be announced in October/November. We must hope that the pro-life cause can win this time.
