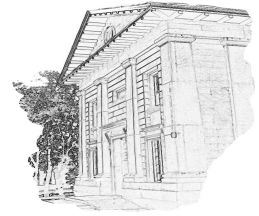

*Father John* believes that those who have already attended courses in the parish this last year have now received or arranged to receive the sacrament of Baptism. The next course will commence in September as stated in the diary. Thank you to all the catechists who work so hard preparing candidates for the Sacraments.

*Confirmation :* Father John was delighted with the Celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation at St Charles Borromeo Church last Monday, and he would like to thank all who helped in any way with this celebration or the preparation of candidates. Please keep the candidates in your daily prayers. We pray that they may become great ambassadors for Christ in the world of today.

*First Holy Communion* will be celebrated at St Mary's Glossop next Sunday, July 4<sup>th</sup>, at 9.30am Mass. Will all parents and children arrive by 9.15am at the latest so that final preparations can be made before the celebration.

*Confessions at All Saints:* Confessions will be available each Saturday at All Saints between 5.45pm–6.15pm.

*Visits to the Sick and Housebound:* *Could Eucharistic* and school authorities make contact with Father Uche so that he can arrange visits to the sick and housebound, and to the schools of the parish.

The annual *Padley Pilgrimage* will take place on Sunday July 11<sup>th</sup>. Many people already take part and Father John would like to encourage as many as possible throughout the parish to come along. This is an inter-diocesan pilgrimage in honour of the Padley martyrs Blessed Robert Ludlam and Blessed Nicholas Garlick. The guest speaker is the Most Reverend Vincent Nicholls, Archbishop of Westminster. You are asked to assemble at 3pm at Grindleford Station. **Mass commences at 3.30 pm.**

The reign of Elizabeth I was a time of religious persecution for English Catholics. In the early morning of July 12<sup>th</sup> 1588, Padley Manor, the residence of the Fitzherbert family, was raided. Two travelling priests and everyone at the hall were arrested. Garlick and Ludlam, along with another priest, Richard Simpson, were gruesomely executed in Derby within the fortnight.

*Taize Evening Prayer* will be held in All Saints Church on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> July at 7.30pm. A peaceful time of song, scripture and silence followed by refreshments. All are most welcome. This is the last meeting before the summer break, the group will recommence, God willing, on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> October.
