We will resume the distribution on Holy Communion under both kinds for our Sunday Masses only as from next weekend. Receiving Holy Communion from the chalice is, of course, a matter of personal choice. It is the clear and constant teaching of the Catholic Church that the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Christ are received whole and entire under either species (i.e. the consecrated host or the chalice).

If you have any concern regarding receiving Holy Communion from the chalice, you do not have to do so. Needless to say, if you are suffering any kind of infection, you ought not to do so.
