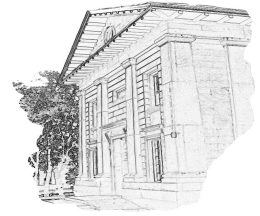

Father John Writes : The feeding of the multitude echoes other passages that would have evoked significant religious and cultural memories, namely: the feeding of the Israelites in the wilderness (Exodus 16: 15-21); Elisha's feeding of a hundred with twenty loaves (2 Kings 4: 42-44); and the Last Supper narrative in the Gospels. The provision of bread for a multitude, following on the distinctive actions of taking, blessing, breaking and giving bread, reveals Jesus' true identity as the Son of God, the one true God who provides for His children in the wilderness. That the multitude 'were filled' is an allusion to Jesus' earlier beatitude: 'Blessed are you who are hungry now, for you shall be filled'.

Confirmation : Father John was pleased to see so many present at the first session of the course and looks forward to being with you for rest of the course . Please keep in mind that the next sessions are as follows:
